## The Peace Leadership Affinity Group (PLAG)

## **Purpose**

The Peace Leadership Affinity Group provides for a forum for those interested in leadership principles that serve a sustainable peace. It wishes to establish a community within ILA that allows for an exchange of ideas, best practices and action plans. It also intends to be a forum to support each member in their efforts towards a more peaceful world.

## **Vision**

Peace is more than the absence of violent conflict (Galtung). It requires a vision of a system of values and practices that promote a peaceful approach to conflict if not a new vision of human identity. It corresponds to the silent revolution in leadership exemplified by the learning organization (Senge). The PLAG provides for a meeting space where those interested in peace and peace leadership can develop concepts, approaches and action plans where 1+1=3 and much more.

## **Principles and Practices**

The ILA PLAG wishes to:

- Be a forum where collaborations between peace leaders is welcome and encouraged
- 2. Provide a forum where those interested in peace leadership can develop networks that serve their peace visions and their peace actions
- 3. Be an information hub for peace leadership events by directing its members to peace information sources
- 4. Promote and support peace leadership initiatives, such as conferences, workshops, etc.
- 5. Support the learning needs of peace leaders by either referring to existing training/education modules or identifying gaps
- 6. Develop synergies between peace leaders, peace workers, peace service organizations and levels of governments developing peace leadership practices
