

Marketing and Publications Internship

The International Leadership Association is now accepting applicants for a Summer 2019 Marketing and Publications Internship. The intern will assist the ILA with messaging and outreach strategies for the organization. This position is also focused on the promotion of ILA publications. The intern will report directly to the Program Coordinator and work closely with the ILA's staff.

Duration: The internship will take place during the June-August 2019 summer semester. The intern could start earlier and/or stay for longer, if desired. Outstanding performance may lead to hourly employment after the internship ends.

Hours: A typical work week will be 3-5 days for 6-8 hours each day in our Silver Spring, MD office.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist with the development and implementation of creative concepts and marketing strategies for promoting the ILA's new books on leadership.
- Promote the visibility and use of the ILA's online "<u>Intersections Portal</u>", where members connect, among members and as a membership benefit
- Coordinate outreach to publishers to build relationships and promote ILA author's books on leadership.

Qualifications:

- Excellent written and interpersonal communication skills.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team.
- Outstanding work ethic.
- Strong attention to detail.
- Interest in leadership knowledge and practice.
- Ideally, a current undergraduate, graduate student, or recent graduate.

The internship is designed to support and foster career development, and offered on a flexible basis so that the intern can fit their internship around studies and other commitments. Although the internship is unpaid, benefits include:
