LEADERSHIP

Union Institute & University's Bachelor of Science in Leadership is an ideal program for those in business, the arts, information technology, sports, health professions, the military, and in non-profit management, or for anyone who wants to make lasting change in their profession.

Learners will analyze, evaluate, and apply a variety of concepts and theories of leadership to their own professional experiences; discuss and evaluate effective management and leadership behaviors and the implications in professional practice; and investigate the connections between ethics and leadership. In addition, they will learn to apply ethical principles to issues in their chosen practice; deepen understanding of the complexity of leadership and how to enhance their capacity to be effective leaders in their chosen field; and identify, assess, lead, and manage change in the professional environment.



The Bachelor of Science in Leadership enables learners to design a multi-disciplinary program tailored toward their chosen career paths. Coursework covers self-assessment, organizational culture, ethics, and change, with a focus on the individual's effectiveness as a leader and motivator in their environment. Emphasis will be placed on mentoring and development of employees, and team building for maximum effectiveness.

Degree completion options:

- Attend on-ground classes that meet face-to-face five times in an eight-week session.
- Select a distance learning option with faculty support.

Complete at least 28 credits in major electives
